ITEMS WHICH CANNOT BE CARRIED
ON ANY PART OF THE AIRCRAFT!

 walking sticks with pointed ends	 hypodermic syringes (unless supported by medical evidence)	 scissors	 firearms inc. toys & replicas (Firearms must be declared and packed separately)	 bullets, ammunition (5 kg max.)	 pistol caps	 bleaches, corrosives (acids, mercury, alkalis)	 oxidising substances	 fireworks, party poppers	 blow torch & chef's blow torch
 nail clippers	 golf clubs, snooker cues	 household cutlery	 knives and blades	 knitting needles	 flammable liquids and solids (inc. chemistry sets)	 wet cell batteries	 compressed gases (eg. butane, propane)	 oil based paints	 poisons
 sporting equipment	 catapults, darts	 tradesmen's tools	 christmas crackers	 Can only be carried in hold luggage and must be in original sealed packaging!	 CS gas, mace & pepper spray	 security protected cases	 gas heated curling tongs	 disposable lighters and strike anywhere matches	 Passengers may only carry one box of safety matches or one non-disposable cigarette lighter. These must be carried in hand luggage only and are not permitted in hold baggage!
